Wirksworth Heritage Centre has been telling the story and history of Wirksworth for the past 30 years. We were created by the Wirksworth Civic Society back in 1986 with the aim of intepreting our local history for visitors and the local community. Our exhibitions don't just show the modern history of the area we all make our home, we have exhibitions which show the development of the area from the prehistoric period, through its Roman and lead mining histories, all the way to the modern era.





CREATING A NEW HERITAGE CENTRE

The Heritage Centre has now started a major redevelopment project, supported by the Heritage Lottery Fund to relocate and create a new venue to house our museum collection, exhibitions which illustrate the story of Wirksworth, and to be the base for a programme of new events and activities from the summer of 2018. The museum collection comprises a small but varied collection of artefacts, including prehistoric stone and antler tools which would have been used by prehistoric humans in this area many thousands of years ago. 
